Staff Reflection

"As the Father has loved me, so I have loved you." I am not sure I have ever really stopped to think about this phrase until I had to read this Gospel in order to write this article. Jesus assures us that he loves us in the same way that his Father loves him! Can we dare to believe that Jesus might want to bless us with this grace and this incredible gift? What is it like for us to sit with this statement? Do we know it deep in our hearts? Do we long to know it deeper and deeper?

And what about Jesus' statement, "Remain in my love. If you keep my commandments, you will remain in my love." How do we "remain" in God's love? I think there are some very practical ways we can do this and as I type it is a reminder to me to make a better effort to do some of these things.

We can remain in Jesus' love by walking and seeking Jesus daily through time in scripture and time reading the Bible. It is through these words and stories that God reveals himself to us. I have not watched The Chosen, but many people have encouraged me to do so. Perhaps this is a way to remain with Jesus, to know him better, to understand his works and message better?

When we wake each morning, do we say a quick "thank you"? Sometime during the day do we practice St. Ignatius' call to pray the Examen – to look at where God has been in our day and where we might have missed him? We can stay connected by asking the Lord to reveal how we can love others each day. We can stay with Him by praying throughout our days and inviting God into every moment. We can take a few quiet moments in the car, on our walk into our office, and on our drive to pick up the kids from practice to listen and be aware of his presence.

"Remain in my love." Lord Jesus, we know your presence is always with us. Help us to love one another and to bring your love and message to all those with whom we meet this week.
