



#### From the Pastor's Desk

#### Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Our Lord Jesus Christ

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Today's solemnity invites us to appreciate deeply the mystery of Our Lord's True Presence in the Holy Eucharist. Our Lord Jesus gave the gift of His Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity as the Memorial of His Passion, as food for our mission, as a source of union with Himself, and as a foretaste of Heaven. Since on Holy Thursday, we celebrate, not only the Institution of the Eucharist, but also the Priesthood and the Mandate of service as well, the Church offers us this extra opportunity to refocus on the Blessed Sacrament. In our day, the Holy Eucharist is so easily taken for granted, and, sadly, so many no longer desire to receive Our Eucharistic Lord. In spite of our unworthiness, neglect, and the indifference of so many, Jesus continues to give Himself to us.

Pope Francis summarizes for us the purpose of this beautiful solemnity: "Thus, the celebration of Corpus Christi is a mystery of attraction to Christ and of transformation in him. And it is the school of concrete love, patient and sacrificed, as Jesus on the Cross. It teaches us to become more welcoming and available to those who are in search of understanding, of help, of encouragement, and are marginalized and alone. Jesus' living presence in the Eucharist is like a door, an open door between the temple and the road, between faith and history, between the city of God and the city of man" (Angelus message, June 3, 2018). May we pray for the grace always to long for Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament!

The month of June also is the month of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Devotion to the Heart of Christ has been part of the theology of many great teachers and mystics including Saint John the Apostle and Evangelist, Saint Bonaventure, and Saint Gertrude the Great. During a particularly difficult time in the 17th Century, as the Jansenist heresy was raging, Our Lord called a Visitation Nun, Saint Margaret Mary Alocoque and her Jesuit Spiritual Director, Saint Claude de le Colombiere, to spread devotion to the Sacred Heart, a powerful reminder of the Incarnation and of the Mercy of God. In these days of trial, indifference, and ingratitude, we need to turn to the Eucharistic Heart of Jesus and recognize the wondrous gift which Jesus offers to us. In a real love for Jesus in the Holy Eucharist, we will see a renewal of the Church, a conversion of hearts, and a transformation of society for the better. I entrust all of you and your loved ones to the Heart of Christ.


