

Staff Reflection

Today's Gospel from Mark is not an easy one. We do not get a pleasant image of Jesus as a friendly shepherd or a familiar parable like the Prodigal Son, Instead, Jesus chooses to respond to the scribes accusing him of using the power of Satan with a parable about breaking into a house. Not quite as warm and fuzzy. But what is really going on here?

We must remember that the scribes are trying to convince the crowd of Christ's followers that Jesus is able to cast out demons by using the power and authority of Satan and not of God. Jesus must explain that if He were using Satan's power, He would be undoing Satan's own evil work, creating a logical fallacy. Instead, Jesus says, "no one can enter a strong man's house to plunder his property unless he first ties up the strong man" (Mk 3:27).

In the parable, the strong man is Satan and the house is his evil domain. The property to be plundered are the people from whom Jesus drives out demons. It is impossible for Jesus to use Satan's power to cast out demons because He must bind Satan in order to free the man. Jesus uses the power of the Holy Spirit to perform miracles and set us free.

In a strange way, Jesus is this thief in the night, coming to free us from Satan's house. Satan wishes to imprison us in his house, but Jesus comes to destroy Satan and all his evil works, binding them and setting us free.

While I doubt this Gospel passage will ever be as beloved as Jesus as the Good Shepherd or the parable of the Prodigal Son, it has much to teach us. Join me in going forward secure in the knowledge that Jesus has come to liberate us from sin and set us free for a beautiful life with Him.
