## Staff Reflection

I just returned from my annual retreat. I was lucky enough to have my retreat at the beach with the ocean just a few yards away. Each morning I would walk the beach and there were 2 days when the wind was very strong – there were whitecaps on the ocean and the sand was blowing around ashore. On these morning walks, I thought about this Gospel passage without realizing it was the Gospel for this Sunday.

In this wonderful story of the calming of the storm at sea, we witness the dynamics of fear and trust. Making their way across the lake, the disciples stand symbolically for all of us journeying through life. When they confront the mighty waves, they are immediately filled with terror. Similarly, when the trials and anxieties of life confront us, often our first reaction is fear.

Jesus is “asleep on a cushion.” Thinking about my own life, Jesus is never asleep at the switch. If anything, I am responsible for my faith life going dormant, allowing the busyness of life to create obstacles and distractions in prayer, peace, and contemplation. He stands for the divine power that is “asleep” within all of us.

At a spiritual level, we see that this divine power successfully calms the waves: “He woke up, rebuked the wind, and said to the sea, ‘Quiet! Be still!’”

This beautiful narrative suggests that if we but awaken to the presence of Christ within us, then we can withstand even the most frightening storms. When, at the close of the story, Jesus asks the bewildered disciples, “Why are you terrified? Do you not yet have faith?” he is wondering why they have not yet experienced the change of heart necessary for living in the kingdom of God.

As we make our way through these wonderful summer months, we are invited by Christ to navigate the calm waters and stormy seas of our lives with him. Be not afraid and keep watch, for he is always at our side. Be still, and listen for Him.

## Sanctuary Memorial Fund



In order to provide for the liturgical needs of the Church and Sanctuary, I am establishing a Sanctuary Memorial Fund. The fund will enable us to purchase new vestments as we need them. (Some of our vestments are getting worn and tattered.) Improvements to the altar would include, altar cloths trimmed in red for certain occasions and a cloth trimmed in blue for Masses and celebrations in honor of Our Lady, along with 2 additional candlesticks for the altar for Solemnities, Forty Hours Devotion, etc.. Another goal is to construct a shrine for our Saint Patrick statue, as well as to purchase a statue of Our Lord with His Sacred Heart. The Sacred Heart statue would be placed in the narthex of the Church.

Donations to this fund are a simple way of memorializing our deceased loved ones. They also could be made in honor of those who are living. Please consider supporting this fund, particularly when planning for the funeral of a loved one. This is a gift to Saint Patrick Parish that will enhance our Divine Encounter.
