



Staff Reflection

"Do not be afraid; just have faith."

What worries you? Perhaps a lack of money or a troubling financial situation? Maybe you're dealing with a serious health situation, or a loved one may be ill. There could be a child who hasn't spoken to you in a while, or some other family member might be estranged. Your job may be in jeopardy, or you may already be out of a job. Each one of us has something that pulls at our heart or concerns us. If we are not careful, then these concerns can turn into a consuming worry, and that worry can turn into fear. But why do we worry? We worry because in our heart, at the core of our being, we just want to know that everything will be "okay." What Jesus is telling us in the Gospel today is that **everything will be okay, so long as we have faith and** we come to Him. We need to have faith in Jesus and come to Him just as Jairus came to Jesus to heal his daughter, and just as the woman with the hemorrhage came to Jesus with her long suffering. When we reach a point of total surrender and trust in our relationship with Jesus, then we will know that everything will be okay even when it is not okay. That is because we will have come to the realization that closeness with Jesus is the ultimate goal. So often suffering, tragedy and trying times bring us to Jesus, just as the sufferings of Jairus and the woman brought them to Jesus. When we give Jesus our trust and surrender, then He gives us peace and joy. This is true even if those challenging life situations don't actually change for the better. Sometimes they will, sometimes they won't. But whether they do or they don't, that goal of wanting to know that everything is okay will be achieved if we end up closer to Jesus in the process. Then that peace & joy that we seek will be attained. Frequent reception of The Eucharist, silent prayer time, and adoration are three of the most powerful ways for that awareness and closeness to happen. Him.
