<u>Catechist</u>	Takes responsibility to prepare each week's lesson and teach children.
<u>Classroom Aide</u>	Assists the catechist with children and management of classroom.
<u>Teen Aide</u>	Helps in classroom and/or helps with logistical needs of the program.
<u>Substitute Catechist</u>	Fills in for catechist when absent.
<u>Office Helper</u>	Helps in office during PREP session; collects absentee forms; makes phone calls; monitors who is entering/leaving building. Rotating basis.
